## 2020 Safety Planning Series

Join us for an informative and engaging training series on Safety Planning. This 6 part series will help you build skills to effectively engage with families to gather and accurately assess information to support your decision making and planning for safety. 	<b>Present Danger Assessment:</b> Identify present danger based upon case information, assess information to support decision making, determine accurate present danger threats and review documentation to support decision making.
	<b>Present Danger Safety Planning:</b> Identify how family engagement determines the type of present danger safety plan, how to assess safety service providers (informal) and how to manage present danger safety plans.
	<b>Information Collection:</b> Focus on types of information to inform information collection domains and engagement of family members and others, and processing information collection documentation of information collection (consider both streamlined and not).
	<b>Impending Danger Decision:</b> Clarify the relationship of caregiver protective capacity and family condition to inform impending danger, identify accurate impending danger threats and review the impending danger threshold criteria to support decision making.
	<b>Impending Danger Safety Plan Decision Making:</b> Review safety planning criteria and application of safety planning analysis as well as conditions for return based upon safety planning analysis.
	<b>Impending Danger Safety Plan Development and Management:</b> Discuss types of safety services, reconciling safety services with family condition and assessing the sufficiency of the safety plan and conditions for return.
